We are pleased to announce that the spouse of one of our graduates has left a bequest to provide scholarships for graduating students of Lake George High School.

Laura Murray Mason graduated from Lake George in 1931. Pursuant to the terms of her husband's will, a portion of his estate has been set aside to establish the Kenneth and Laura Mason Scholarship. The bequest totaled \$16,628.09.

According to New York State Law, an unincorporated association may not receive property by will. Therefore, in order to accept the bequest, a not-for-profit corporation has been formed. All the necessary legal papers have been filed creating the Lake George High School Alumni Association, Inc. It's function will be to receive the bequest from the Estate of Kenneth Mason and award scholarships. It will not alter the present association in any way or change the current scholarships which we now award. Gifts to the present fund for that purpose will still be graciously appreciated. Membership is open to any graduates of Lake George High School. There is no membership fee.

A bank account has been opened with the Lake George Branch of the Glens Falls National Bank. Presently, Grace E. Morehouse serves as President, Fran LaPan, Vice-President and Michael Stafford, Secretary and Treasurer. All three constitute the current Board of Directors. Rebecca Herrick of DeLong and Herrick will act as our certified accountant.
