


2012 LAKE GEORGE ALUMNI BANQUET, “Blast from the Past '62” Honoring the Class of 1962



WALL OF HONOR - 2012

CARL R. DESANTIS



Carl graduated with the Class of 1944 and continued on to Skidmore College after serving his country in the US Army Air Force. In 1943 he, with his father's encouragement, opened the first of many well known restaurants in the Upstate New York area. As the Adirondack Northway became reality, he was visionary enough to foresee the potential for more successful restaurants. His perseverance in the food industry led to continued success and over the years resulted in ownership and operational responsibility for six Howard Johnson's franchises, and three additional independently owned restaurants. Carl has always had a keen interest in helping other people, and by using employment at his restaurant, created opportunities for thousands of young folks with need for seasonal, and often, long term employment. Throughout his business career, Carl has always been involved in civic affairs, serving as Lake George councilman, President of the NYS Restaurant Association, Director of Adirondack Regional Chamber of Commerce, and myriad other key leadership positions. As Chairman of the Lake George Park Commission, Carl's actions have enhanced the betterment of the entire Adirondack Region, including Lake George. Now retired, Carl and his wife, Barbara, reside near Lake George. They are the proud parents of five children, eleven grandchildren, and three great grandchildren.

EDUCATOR AWARD: 2012 Recipients

Douglas and Barbara Wilson showered their students at Lake George Jr. Sr. High School with sincere and loyal dedication. They are a married couple that worked every day together and actually had the entire third floor at the school to use as a showcase teaching room that enhance the best from their students. Together they were an incredibly positive influence on all their students lives due to their own love, appreciation and creative art abilities. Marla Meyers a former student gave a beautiful introduction as they were welcomed to accept their award. Doug and Barbara have been retired for several years though still substitute as needed.

COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD: 2012 Recipient

Charles "Chuck" '40 and Ruth Hawley - The committee realized their generosity over a lifetime of giving of themselves led to the enrichment of so many folks, young and old through the many organizations and programs that were strengthened and supported by their work and that still exist today. Charles was the artist and Ruth the teacher and promoter. Chuck dedicated his life to protecting Lake George. As an artist, Chuck was able to capture the pristine Lake that always moved him toward the guarding of its well being. As a town supervisor he was able to continue the watch. As a member of the Lake George Park Commission for 30 years he generated much stronger support for the care.

Ruth was devoted to her Troop 8 Girl Scouts for many years along with friend Doris Bruno. She was a communicant of Sacred Heart Church in Lake George and a religious education teacher. She was a volunteer in the Girl Scouts of America and became the historian on the Archive Committee. She received the highest award of a Girl Scout Volunteer, the Girl Scout's "Thanks" Badge. She was a volunteer docent with the Hyde Collection of Glens Falls, a member of the Lake George Historical Association, and a member of the Lake George Planning Board for many years.

Both Chuck and Ruth assisted with the publication of the Lake George Sacred Heart Church stain glass window guide booklet depicting the story of Father Isaac Jogues, a Jesuit missionary from Orleans, France, believed to be the first European to discover beautiful Lake George in 1646.

And so it goes, as a couple they continued to always show their love and passion for the Lake by teaching it's history, staying aware of the protection and nurturing needs and willing to stand up for the right steps in growth and development. Their legacy was a lifetime achievement for the Hawleys.


