During the trip he traveled across Nebraska and Iowa during the heat wave which necessitated getting on the road at sunrise and off the road by 1 p.m. During the course of the trip Jerry lost a total of 50 lbs. despite drinking gallons of liquids each day and eating huge nightly meals. It was necessary to consume 9,000 to 10,000 calories a day! When Jerry reached the Mississippi temperatures were less oppressive and he began to make fantastic time--crossed Illinois in two days, Indiana in two days and Ohio in two and a half days. In Pittsburgh, Pa. he began to encounter heavier traffic and found a bike trail he could ride all the way to Maryland, where he picked up another bike trail that runs along the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to D.C. His son met him in D.C. and rode the last 15 miles of the trip with him. He takes 25 mile rides every day now and it feels like nothing. Jerry is an emergency room doctor in a hospital in Amsterdam and currently resides in Cambridge with his family.
