Mr. Fry was a Financial Planner and Certified Life Underwriter with Mass Mutual for 43 years. He was a Past President of the Schenectady Jr Chamber of Commerce, President of Union College Alumni Association and a member of the Lake George Alumni Association. Wes died in September 2001.
