ALUMNI ROOM GOES ONLINE AT HIGH SCHOOL

"Thanks to the hard work of the Lake George Alumni Association and staff members, a state-of-the-art technology room is now available to the students and faculty of Lake George. This special room is located just inside the High School Library Media Center and displays many new technologies. Video conferencing is now possible, allowing students and faculty to interact with people around the world. A high-end computer with multimedia capabilities, DVD/VCR player, sound system, and an LCD projection unit are part of this system. Students will be able to take virtual tours of museums like the Smithsonian or Metropolitan. Students could also work on video editing and movie production since the equipment can handle almost anything."

In addition to the media equipment, the High School is creating an Alumni "Hall of Fame" to honor Lake George graduates who have made a special contribution to their communities or achieved a level of success in their chosen field. Pictures and biographies will be displayed on the walls of the new Alumni Room.. The first picture in the Alumni Hall of Fame will be **James "Wes" Fry**, Class of 1942. Wes was a graduate of Union College and a financial planner for Mass Mutual Life Insurance Co. He died in 2001. Wes set up a very generous scholarship fund for Lake George students who plan to attend Union College. The first recipient of the Scholarship is **Michael Kissane**, Class of 2003.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

Sgt. First Class **John Hawley** (Class of 1984) became the only member of the US Army to receive the "Grateful Nation Award" for distinguished service during the war on terrorism.

The award is given by the Jewish Institute for National Security Affairs. Sgt. Hawley served eight months in Afghanistan, and received a Bronze Star for his service as company commander for a battalion in the 82nd Airborne Division.

Robert Moon (Class of 1943) was honored at a surprise party for his many years of public service. Bob has held the post of Warren County deputy fire coordinator or 42 years and serves as a part-time building inspector. He has been seven decades with the fire department and still responds to fires every day. Five of the medals that he earned in World War II were presented at the party along with a letter from the White House. Lake George Mayor Bob Blaise issued a proclamation naming January, 2004, as "Robert Moon Month".

TEACHERS OF THE YEAR

In 2003 the Association presented Teacher's Awards to Bob and Inky Remais. Bob and Inky were teachers at Lake George from 1947 to 1954. Inky taught both kindergarten and vocal music and Bob was instructor for instrumental lessons and junior and senior bands. (the senior band almost always came back from music competitions with an "A" rating. They presently reside in Myrtle Beach, SC area, where they can play golf most of the year.
