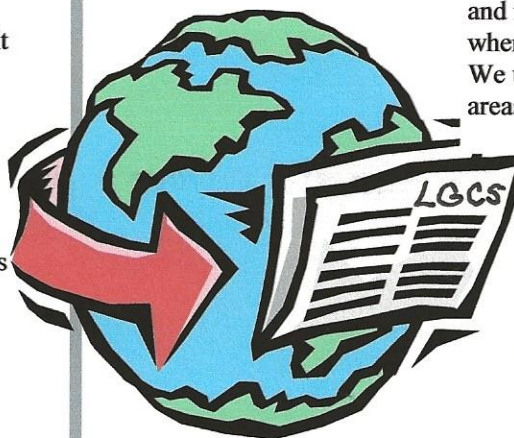
ALUMNI CONTRIBUTES TO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

In 2001 the Alumni Association instituted a new program, to help the high school raise funds for the new Media Room. To date we have contributed over \$15,000 to the High School.

This year the Association voted to expand the program to include needs of the Elementary School. We asked the Lake George PTSO for their recommendations for areas that needed funding, and they were quick to offer suggestions.

In June of this year, we presented a check in the amount of \$1,950 to purchase educational games and manipulatives to be used in the classrooms when inclement weather forces indoor recess.

We understand that educational games, in various areas of learning have been ordered. We hope to
